PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

CONFIX EC is a three-part, epoxy-modified cementitious, fine-textured mortar for self-smoothing floor screeds in thin layers of 1.5 to 3 mm. It is easy and quick to apply and forms an ideal substrate for the application of self-leveling coatings.

CONFIX EC may be coated after just 24 hours with epoxy or polyurethane systems, even if applied on concrete, which is not fully cured, damp, or subject to rising capillary dampness. It impedes and prevents the formation of blisters and detachment of successive resin coatings.

CONFIX EC is a solvent-free product supplied in predosed packaging and is easy to apply to form a flat, smooth finish.

The final performance characteristics of **CONFIX EC** guarantee an excellent bond with hardened concrete, even when not fully cured and still damp.

The product is also particularly strong and has good resistance to chemicals in general. **CONFIX EC** offers excellent resistance to water and oil and resists attacks from de-icing salts. It has improved chemical resistance over plain concrete in aggressive environments but is not designed as chemical protection.

RECOMMENDED FOR:

As a temporary moisture barrier (min. 2 mm thick) allowing the application of epoxy, polyurethane, and resin floors requiring dry substrates, over high moisture content substrate, even green concrete, for a lasting solution.

AS A SELF-SMOOTHING SCREED FOR:

- Leveling or patching horizontal concrete substrate
- Leveling layer on rough concrete flooring or concrete flooring roughened by grinding
- Smoothing over damp concrete surfaces before applying epoxy or polyurethane coatings.
- Thin repair layers on the surface of damp substrates that do not require a particularly attractive finish
- Repair and maintenance work on monolithic or steam-cured concrete floors.

INSTRUCTION FOR USE

SURFACE PREPARATION

Concrete surfaces must be free of dirt, paint, oil grease, loose materials, and other contaminants. On oil surfaces, washing with soap and water or acid etching (10% muriatic acid or hydrochloric acid) is recommended. Damp the surface before application of **CONFIX EC.**

MIXING:

Pour Part A and Part B into a suitable mixing container. Mix well until uniform color is obtained. Add gradually Part C to the solution while stirring with a slow-speed electric mixer. Mix thoroughly until a uniform mix has been achieved with no lumps.

Mix only full units of A+B+C components. Do not mix smaller amounts. Do not add water.

APPLICATION

After thorough blending of the mixture has been done, place mixed **CONFIX EC** onto the primed substrate and spread evenly to the required thickness uniformly with a rubber or metal trowel or spatula and immediately roll with a spike roller to remove entrapped air to obtain an even thickness layer. Workability can be adjusted by varying slightly the amount of Part C.

Do not use additional water, which would disturb the surface finish and cause discoloration.

CLEAN UP

Clean all tools and application equipment with water immediately after use. Hardened/cured material can only be removed mechanically.

LIMITATIONS

If **CONFIX EC** is used as TMB (Temporary Moisture Barrier), a layer of a minimum of 2 mm thick must be applied. Always ensure good ventilation when using **CONFIX EC** in a confined space to remove excess moisture. Freshly applied **CONFIX EC** must be protected from damp, condensation, and water for at least 24 hours. Prevent premature drying by protecting from strong wind and do not expose to direct sunlight while fresh.

PACKAGING

CONFIX EC is supplied in 3 components consisting of base, hardener, and filler in a 16kg set.

STORAGE AND HANDLING

CONFIX EC has a shelf life of 24 months if stored in a dry cool place unopened. Store in a dry condition away from sources of heat and naked flames. If stored at high temperatures the shelf life will be reduced.

PRECAUTIONS
